Rose petal, Turkish delight, black cherry, leafy aromas with savoury tannins.

WINEMAKER

Adam Louder

WINEMAKING

100% Pyrenees Nebbiolo. Hand picked and plunged. Whole berry ferment. 16 months in French oak. 15% new oak. No fining. 12 months in bottle pre-release. Contains sulphites. Vegan.

VINEYARD

Hand picked from Malakoff Estate Vineyard, Pyrenees, Victoria.

VINTAGE

The 2019 growing season was warm and dry. Severe winds during flowering led to lower than normal fruit set. Nebbiolo vine yields were lower than average but grape concentration and flavour were high.

100% Pyrenees Nebbiolo
