ABOUT SUBROSA

Located in the historic Grampians wine region in Victoria, Australia, SubRosa produces 400 cases/year of handcrafted small batch premium wine.

Intuitive winemaker Adam Louder crafts complex cool climate wines using his experience from 40 vintages in 25 years from Bordeaux, Napa Valley and Australia.

REVIEW

The love for this wine springs from the way the fruit presents as sweet while, at the same time, the back half of the wine presents as decisively dry. The drawbridge between the sweet and dry aspects of this wine is a smoky/savoury nuttiness, which itself is complemented by trademark regional pepper. It's well structured, well balanced, well textured and, plainly, very good.

Aromas of dark berries, plums and undertones of earthiness. An elegant, fruit-driven style of shiraz.

WINEMAKING

Hand picked and plunged. 30% new oak. 16 months in French oak. Vegan.

VINEYARD

Hand picked from the north east corner of the Grampians. Shiraz vines were planted in the 1990's and are grown in granite soil.

VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season was challenging with cool and wet conditions. Vine yields were higher than previous years. The long slow ripening season led to grape complexity.
